# SAFE HOME

Our safe home focuses on nurturing children back to health so they have the opportunity to reach their full potential.

TTL provides a safe haven for children under five who are suffering from malnutrition, HIV/AIDS, TB, or other illnesses.

Our dedicated safe home staff, or "house mothers", provide around-the-clock loving care to the most vulnerable children in the Mokhotlong community.

In 2025, we cared for 27 children in the safe home and rehabilitated them back to health before reuniting them with their families and guardians. Through our outreach program, we continue to offer these children and families support.



# OUTREACH



Our mission is to provide holistic health and nutrition support to children under five throughout Mokhotlong. Our outreach program supports the health and wellbeing of these children through our home visiting program.

We assess children in our community for growth and nutrition benchmarks, and deliver personalized care to families in rural communities based on their needs. Most of our outreach clients are supported with nutritious food packages. Children with moderate to severe malnutrition are referred to our safe home program.

In its 23rd year, our outreach program ensures we have deep connections throughout our community, so no child is left behind.

This year, we made **710** home visits and conducted health and nutrition assessments for over **1000** children throughout the district.

# EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

TTL supports **16** early childhood education schools in Mokhotlong. We help pay for school fees and supply nutritious meals for the children to learn and grow.

In 2025, we successfully built **5** kitchens for the schools and had over **100** graduates. In total, we supported **652** children through our ECE schools.



## Vegetable Production

In 2024, we built 3 community gardens in the Mokhotlong district. In 2025, we continued to support these three communities, Matsoaing, Ha Tsoeu, and Molumong, by aiding in food preservation and soil preparation. We also educated communities on pest control.

We distributed 123 seed packs in collaboration with the Ministry of Agriculture.

Through these initiatives, we assisted 151 individuals in producing food themselves and sustainably storing it.


## Nutrition Campaigns

At TTL, we organize and run nutrition community campaigns throughout the Mokhotlong district, where families with young children come to be assessed for malnutrition.

These campaigns are important because they ensure wide coverage throughout Mokhotlong.

Children who need nutrition assistance are referred to one of TTL's services. This year, we were able to assess **1,117** children.

# SUCCESS STORY



In 2025, we saw amazing growth in our early childhood education centers (ECE). At TTL, we believe in holistic care for the children we serve. In addition to our outreach and safe home program, we work to provide early education opportunities where children receive nutritious meals while they learn and grow.

This year, we celebrated with some previous safe home and outreach clients as they graduated from our ECE schools.


# GROWTH
